The competition is open to innovative, entertaining, intelligent short films. The film will be judged by professionals working in film industry and prizes will be awarded for the best 3 entries.

Submission Guidelines:

Films should be up to 5 minutes in length. Run time includes the credit at the beginning and end of the film. Films may be shorter than 5 minutes, more than that may be disqualified. Once the short film has been submitted, we will not accept substitutions or new versions. The entrant(s) must ensure that s/he or the group is/are the creator of work and that it does not infringe on any existing copyright.

All entrants shall retain the rights to their submitted film.

Entering the competition constitutes permission to use the entrant's names and likeness for publicity and promotions. The BSS reserves the right to publicize and promote any and all progress, development and success of the entered short films.

Entry Fee Rs. 100/- per DVD at the time of submission.

Number of entry unrestricted.

The film could be made by an individual or by a group

Last date of submission- 25th. February 2012

All copies will be retained by BSS for archival and educational purposes.

Results will be declared during the programme to be held on 10th. March 2012. Venue will be announced and informed through the contact address and email id that you may provide while registration.

Films can address specific issues, but we're also keen to encourage innovative interpretations wider aims as mentioned above.
